Eligibility for the Famis programs

Who is Eligible?

- Students under 19 attending your schools.
- Virginia residents and US citizens or qualified legal immigrants.
- Families whose income is within the FAMIS programs limits.

A family of 4 can make as much as \$51,455 per year and the children still qualify.
