Programs for Non-Pregnant Adults

Program	Who's Covered	Income Eligibility	Benefits
Adult Medicaid Expansion (MedEx)	Adults ages 19 – 64 who are not eligible for Medicare	≤138% FPL	Full-benefit Medicaid (emphasis on prevention)
Low Income Families with Children (LIFC)	Parents or a caretaker relative of dependent children <18	<50% FPL, based on locality of residence	Full-benefit Medicaid
Medicaid for Former Foster Care Youth (FFC)	19-25 year olds who aged out of state foster care	Regardless of Income	Full-benefit Medicaid
Plan First	Over age 19	139 – 205% FPL	Limited Family Planning Benefits Only

Programs for Pregnant Virginians



Program	Who's Covered	Income Eligibility	Benefits
Medicaid for Pregnant Women (MPW)*	Legally-Residing Pregnant People	0 – 148% FPL	Full-benefit Coverage (for duration of pregnancy and 12 months postpartum)
FAMIS MOMS	Legally-Residing Pregnant People	149 – 205% FPL	
FAMIS Prenatal	Pregnant People without Legal Immigration Status	0 – 205% FPL	Full-benefit Coverage (for duration of pregnancy and 60 days postpartum)

**Throughout the pandemic, most MPW enrollees have stayed enrolled beyond 60 days postpartum, FAMIS MOMS and FAMIS Prenatal enrollees did not.*

Program	Who's Covered	Income Eligibility	Benefits
FAMIS Plus	Children aged 0-18*	0 – 148% FPL	Full-benefit Coverage
FAMIS	Children aged 0-18	149 – 205% FPL	Full-benefit Coverage

**Throughout the pandemic, most FAMIS Plus kids who turn 19 stayed enrolled in that category.*
