### Choosing a Managed Care Organization (MCO)

Within the first two months of being approved for Medicaid/FAMIS coverage, most enrollees are automatically enrolled in an MCO. Enrollees who were automatically assigned to an MCO can change to a different MCO within the first 90 days of becoming enrolled in an MCO.
